MAPPING TIME: ILLUSTRATED TALK BY MARY SPARKS

How has the landscape of eastern Purbeck changed over time?

Who were the 'Lords of the manors' and what did they control?

Mary Sparks will share her 'research in progress', using maps and documents from different periods to explore land holding patterns from Edward the Confessor's reign to the present day. She will interrogate ideas about 'the Manor', assessing how these ideas relate to what actually existed on the ground. Coloured parish tithe maps of Swanage, Studland, Langton Matravers, Worth Matravers and Corfe from c.1840 showing land ownership will be presented, and Afflington Manor will feature as a focussed example of the wider picture.

Dr Mary Sparks is a local historian who has researched aspects of village life in Worth Matravers in the 19th and 20th Centuries, including the 'Social Mobility of the Country Cottage'. She also used maps in her research on Sarajevo - in that context to explore themes of segregation and social integration in the city. We will display copies of some of the old maps at the talk.
